Isn't it amazing? Faith sprouts and grows and blooms when the time comes. It's God's timing and we do not know when it will come. Sometimes it looks dormant with nothing happening but God continues to water and nurture our faith through words, meals, and through each other. I give thanks for the faith our Good Shepherd family shares with one another. It helps me to grow, too.



Highlights from May Council Meetings


- Treasurer, Jay Andrews presented the April report and it was approved by Bari Raymer and seconded by Don Wienand. The electric bill was \$212.16 and gas bill was \$553.20.
- Worship committee – 1st Sunday in August is the outdoor service @ 10:00 a.m. followed by potluck.
- Stewardship committee - May 20 will be cling on Sunday and potluck. There are 2 different designs available. It is also Pentecost and everyone is encouraged to wear red.
- Property committee – regulator needs to be replaced. It has been quoted around \$1700 plus.
- Scholarship committee - scholarship checks have been mailed out for last year's recipients. This year, the committee reviewed and accepted the scholarship application form from Anna Patterson. She will be award the \$1000 scholarship at worship on Sunday, May 6 and Honor's Night on May 9 at Lena Winslow High School.
- Learning committee – Owl Night coming up on May 18-19. We are working on VBS to be held on June 18-21 at United Methodist Church. Looking for volunteers.
- Men's Group – Meat and potluck on June 17th.
- Youth Gathering in Houston, TX . Anna Patterson reported that she had raised \$1002 through fund raisers and requested \$498 from the council to fund her trip, which costs \$1500. The \$1500 includes transportation and place to stay. It was discussed where the funds could come from. Virgil Gordon made a motion to have Jay contact the donor for the camp fund to see if they would be ok for us to use the funds from there for Anna's trip. In the event the donor would like to keep the funds in the account for a future camper, the 2nd source would be the interest fund.


