Lesson 1: *Isaiah 62:6-12*

L: A reading from the prophet Isaiah.

⁶ On your walls, O Jerusalem, I have set watchmen;
all the day and all the night they shall never be silent.

⁷ You who put the LORD in remembrance, take no rest,
and give him no rest until he establishes Jerusalem
and makes it a praise in the earth.

⁸ The LORD has sworn by his right hand and by his mighty arm:
“I will not again give your grain to be food for your enemies,
and foreigners shall not drink your wine
for which you have labored;

⁹ but those who garner it shall eat it and praise the LORD,
and those who gather it shall drink it
in the courts of my sanctuary.”

¹⁰ Go through, go through the gates;
prepare the way for the people;
build up, build up the highway; clear it of stones;
lift up a signal over the peoples.

¹¹ Behold, the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the earth:
Say to the daughter of Zion, Behold, your salvation comes;
behold, his reward is with him,
and his recompense before him.”

¹² And they shall be called The Holy People,
The Redeemed of the LORD;
and you shall be called Sought Out,
A City Not Forsaken. *[ESV]*

Lesson 2: *Isaiah 52:7-10*

L: A reading from the prophet Isaiah.

⁷ How beautiful upon the mountains
are the feet of him who brings good news,
who publishes peace, who brings good news of happiness,
who publishes salvation,
who says to Zion, “Your God reigns.”

⁸ The voice of your watchmen—they lift up their voice;
together they sing for joy;
for eye to eye they see
the return of the LORD to Zion.

⁹ Break forth together into singing,
you waste places of Jerusalem,
for the LORD has comforted his people;
he has redeemed Jerusalem.

¹⁰ The LORD has bared his holy arm

Lesson 3: *Hebrews 1:1-12*

L: A reading from the letter to the Hebrews.

1 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, ² but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. ³ He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴ having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.

⁵ For to which of the angels did God ever say,
 “You are my Son,
 today I have begotten you”?

Or again,

 “I will be to him a father,
 and he shall be to me a son”?

⁶ And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says,
 “Let all God's angels worship him.”

⁷ Of the angels he says,
 “He makes his angels winds,
 and his ministers a flame of fire.”

⁸ But of the Son he says,
 “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever,
 the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom.
⁹ You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness;
 therefore God, your God, has anointed you
 with the oil of gladness beyond your companions.”

¹⁰ And,
 “You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning,
 and the heavens are the work of your hands;
¹¹ they will perish, but you remain;
 they will all wear out like a garment,
¹² like a robe you will roll them up,
 like a garment they will be changed.
But you are the same,
 and your years will have no end.” [ESV]

Lesson 4: *Titus 3:4-7*

L: A reading from Paul's letter to Titus.

⁴ But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, ⁵ he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, ⁷ so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life. * **Gospel: *Luke 2:1-20***

P: The Holy Gospel according to Luke.

C: *Glory to you, O Lord.*

2 In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. ² This was the registration before Quirinius was governor of Syria. ³ And all went to be registered, each to his own town. ⁴ And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, ⁵ to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. ⁶ And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth. ⁷ And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the guest room.

⁸ And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹ And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear.

¹⁰ And the angel said to them, “Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. ¹¹ For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. ¹² And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger.” ¹³ And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying,

¹⁴ “Glory to God in the highest,
and on earth peace, good will among men.”

¹⁵ When the angels went away from them into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, “Let us go over to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us.” ¹⁶ And they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger. ¹⁷ And when they saw it, they made known the saying that had been told them concerning this child. ¹⁸ And all who heard it wondered at what the shepherds told them. ¹⁹ But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart. ²⁰ And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them.
